I NEED YOUR HELP,

We will need to put together a Color corp. which is a four man team (two as guards and two for flags).

I will be asking for volunteers to create this Color Corp, It will be at least 4 Sir Knights that have **FULL REGALIA** for this duty and will give a full explanation at the September meeting.

One of the duties of a Faithful Navigator is to appoint a Color Corp. Commander. The duties of this position is to lead the Color Guard and Honor Guard. This Sir Knight must know the 4th degree drill manual, which contains sword drills, color guard drills, sword commands and basic functions of both a color guard and honor guard. So, keeping this in mind this person will either have to be someone that has performed in these functions or is willing to learn them.

For those of you who don't know how to recognize CC Commander, he is the Sir Knight with the Purple Cape and Purple plums on his Chapeau.

At this point in time the Assembly doesn't have the funds to purchase the purple cape or Chapeau at a price of \$212.00 plus shipping. I will appoint myself to this position, unless someone has a strong desire to hold this position.

The next order of business would be to have volunteers for honor guards. These man in **FULL REGALIA** would stand at special events and most importantly at funeral visitations. For easy on all, 6 Sir Knights would be ideal for funeral visitation, 3 two man shifts. However the more volunteers we have the better we will be.

Keep in mind that all knights don't have the honor of an honor guard, it is reserved to Sir Knights and in some circumstances 3rd degree knights. Also for both, the wishes of the family of the departed brother will take precedence if an honor guard will be present.

Also, Please remember that you don't have to purchase your regalia immediately when becoming a Sir Knight, I know how tight money is at this time, but at some point if you are able to perform and have the extra money please do. The average cost is around \$480.00.

The last order of business is to come up with an activity that our Assembly can participate in yearly. I will be asking for ideas from the floor at our next meeting.

Please feel free to come up with ideas and we will talk about them at the September meeting.
